1. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this Circular is, among other things, to give you notice of the AGM and to provide you with information in relation to the resolutions to be proposed at the AGM to enable you to make an informed decision on whether to vote for or against those resolutions at the AGM.

2. PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

Reference is made to the announcement of the Company dated March 25, 2024 in relation to the Board's recommendation to make amendments to the Articles of Association.

The Board proposes to amend the Articles of Association for the purpose of, bringing them in line with the latest regulatory requirements in relation to the expanded paperless listing regime and the electronic dissemination of corporate communications made to the Listing Rules which took effect from December 31, 2023 (the "**Proposed Amendments**").

The Proposed Amendments to the Articles of Association are set out in Appendix I to this Circular. According to the Articles of Association and the relevant laws and regulations, the Proposed Amendments to the Articles of Association are subject to consideration and approval by the Shareholders at the AGM by way of special resolution.

The legal advisers to the Company as to the laws of Hong Kong and the laws of the PRC have respectively confirmed that the Proposed Amendments comply with requirements of the Listing Rules and applicable laws of the PRC. There is nothing unusual about the Proposed Amendments for a company incorporated in the PRC and listed on the Stock Exchange.

3. PROPOSED GENERAL MANDATE TO ISSUE H SHARES

In order to increase the flexibility and efficiency in operation, and to give discretion to the Board in the event that it becomes desirable to issue H Shares, the Company proposes to obtain the Shareholders' approval for the grant of the general mandate to separately or concurrently allot, issue and/or deal with additional H Shares up to the limit of 20% of the H Shares in issue on the date of the passing of the relevant resolution at the AGM. Any exercise of the power by the Directors under the general mandate shall comply with the relevant requirements of the Listing Rules, the Articles of Association and the applicable laws and regulations of the PRC.
